

ORDINANCE NO. 1180

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FEES ASSOCIATED WITH FIRE SERVICES IN SECTION 7.32.070 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD, IOWA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF FAIRFIELD, IOWA:

Section 1. The Fairfield Municipal Code is hereby amended to update fee structures for services and materials, rates, and procedures for the above-mentioned chapter.

Section 2. PURPOSE AND INTENT

It is the purpose and intent of these amendments to promote the public safety, health and general welfare; have the fee structures for these material and services applications reflect the true costs of the same when used in such Public Safety activity.

Section 3. SUBSTITUTING AMENDMENT.

A. Chapter 7.32.070 – Fire Protection Service Fee.

Changes as stated hereafter per call shall be assessed by the City to the owner of the premises for services rendered and/or materials provided by the Fairfield Fire Department relating to response to such calls, either within, or outside, the corporate limits of the City of Fairfield and/or the City of Fairfield and/or township serviced.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall, after its final passage, approval and publication, as provided by law, be in full force and effect.
