

ORDINANCE NO. 1178

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BLOCKING STREETS FOR
CONSTRUCTION IN SECTION 11.12.030 AND SNOW REMOVAL BY
THE CITY IN SECTION 11.32.060 TO THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE
CITY OF FAIRFIELD, IOWA.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF FAIRFIELD, IOWA:

Section 1. The Fairfield Municipal Code is hereby amended for the above-mentioned chapter.

Section 2. PURPOSE AND INTENT

It is the purpose and intent of these amendments to promote the public safety, health and general welfare and align the Code with current practices.

Section 3. SUBSTITUTING AMENDMENT. Fairfield Municipal Code Section 11.12.030 is Amended by Substituting the following:

- (c) Applicants may rent Traffic Control devices from the City of Fairfield Streets Department at rates established by Resolution.

Section 4. SUBSTITUTING AMENDMENT. Fairfield Municipal Code Section 11.32.060 is Amended by Substituting the following:


In the event the owner and/or occupant fails to remove the accumulation of snow and/or ice by the time designated herein, it shall be the option of the city to cause the same to be done at the labor and equipment rates established by Resolution, which expense shall be paid by the owner and/or occupant of the property.

Section 5. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such an adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be effective after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law be in full force and effect.


