AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THAT PART OF ORDINANCE 968 (2002) WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE ANNUAL REPORT OF THE BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION TO THE CITY COUNCIL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF FAIRFIELD, IOWA:

Section 1. REPEALER. Section 20.86.030 which provides as follows:

“. The Commission, shall provide an Annual Report reviewing the prior year
IS HEREBY REPEALED.

Section 2. SUBSTITUTING AMENDMENT. Section 2.86.030 shall now read as follows:

“. The COMMISSION, as soon as convenient, after the end of the year, shall provide an Annual Report reviewing the prior year and presenting plans for the forthcoming year.”

Section 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such an adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall, after its final passage, approval and publication, as provided by law, be in full force and effect.



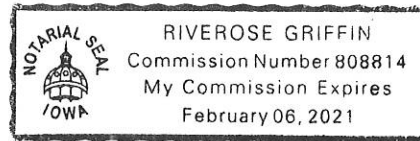
